The Water Tower core programs include applied research, technology innovation, workforce training, and industry engagement. The Strategic Projects intern position will be a crossfunctional role to support projects across these core programs.

This internship offers a unique opportunity to gain experience working in a forward-thinking nonprofit setting to gain hands-on experience in strategic project management, problem solving, critical thinking, and communications.

Mission

The mission of The Water Tower is to be the hub for water industry solutions ensuring thriving communities and a safe environment. The Strategic Projects Intern will contribute directly to TWT's by supporting key programs, initiatives, and events in the areas of research, workforce development, industry engagement, and technology innovation.

Duties and Responsibilities

The Strategic Projects Intern will be responsible for the following tasks:

- Provide research and administrative support for the nearly \$2M Water Hub workforce training grant program
- Develop and grow outreach programs such as the Friends of The Water Tower individual giving program, a scout water badge program, license plate program, and more
- Develop and implement a comprehensive inventory system to track TWT assets
- Attend, support, and photograph TWT-hosted and rental events including workshops, conferences, networking receptions, etc.
- Update and maintain stakeholder mailing lists to grow the organizations audience and reach
- Attend meetings with TWT staff and collaborators
- Perform other duties as assigned or directed to meet the goals and objectives of the organization
